Performance Monitoring

❖ Periodic Reviews

- Quarterly Progress Notifications – Emailed to Participants
- Semi-Annual Feedback – Summarizes Participation and Status of Agency-specific Action Items
- Annual Reporting
 - Gather Feedback from Participants through Surveys
 - Discuss Results in Review Meetings with Districts and Agencies
 - Publish Results in Annual Reports
