

We are sending this Advance Notification (AN) Package to your office and distributing to Federal, State and Local agencies in accordance with Florida Department of Transportation Project Development & Environment (PD&E) Manual. This information is being provided for a PD&E Study for the above project. Although we will request specific comments during the permitting process, we are asking that permitting and permit reviewing agencies review the attached information and provide us with their comments.

This is a non-Federal aid action and the Florida Department of Transportation will determine what type of environmental documentation is necessary. The determination will be based upon in-house environmental evaluations and comments from other agencies. A consistency review for this project is not required by 15 CFR 930 because no Federal Funds are involved.

In addition, please review this project's consistency, to the maximum extent feasible, with the approved Comprehensive Plan of the local government to comply with Chapter 163 of the Florida Statutes.

We look forward to receiving your comments on this project within 45 days. Should additional review time be required, a written request for a 15 day extension must be submitted to our office within the initial 45-day comment period.
